McKinney Park - 625 West Pool Rd, Odessa, TX

(9) Nine Hole Course

Description: A short and technical nine hole course tucked between the two main courses at Comanche Trail Park. Holes 1, 7, 8 and 9 are in the open part of McKinney Park while holes 2 through 6 are tucked in the trees. McKinney Park is a favorite of local disc golfers and an excellent course to play during a lunch hour.

- Hole 1:** 212 ft (Par 3) - Hole 1 tee box is located next to the NE corner of the basketball court. Basket is located in the corner of the park in front of the McKinney Park sign. Cement walking path and beyond as well as the pavement is OB.
- Hole 2:** 264 ft (Par 3) - Players must walk across crosswalk (immediately past #1 basket across Crane hwy) to the tee box located next to the big rocks. Basket is located straight ahead 30 ft into the trees. Walking path and beyond to the left and fence (Unifirst property) is OB. Do not climb over/under Unifirst fence to fetch discs.
- Hole 3:** 150 ft (Par 3) - Short hole with a very tight fairway. Basket is straight ahead and slightly to the right. Walking path and beyond as well as the fence to the right is OB.
- Hole 4:** 266 ft (Par3) - The most hated and difficult hole at McKinney Park. Walking path and beyond is OB. Tee shots must stay right of the path. Golfers can choose to lay up or go for it.
- Hole 5:** 229 ft (Par3) - A tight fairway curves slightly to the left to the basket. Walking path and beyond to the left is OB.

- Hole 6:** 290 ft (Par3) - A scenic but challenging hole. Basket is straight ahead behind the half mulberry, half mesquite tree growing out of the big rocks. Walking path and beyond is OB. Pavement is out of bounds. Cable running through red poles serves as OB line for this hole.
- Hole 7:** 287 ft (Par3) - Tee box is located across the crosswalk close to #1 basket. Basket is straight ahead in the trees and sits on the slope of the hill. Pavement and cement are OB. Walking path and beyond is OB. Cement runs behind basket and can't be seen from tee box.
- Hole 8:** 514 ft (Par3) - The big arms favorite hole. Original tee box located 100 ft left of #7 basket. Wide open hole with a few big, tall trees along the way. Basket is located on top of a hill straight ahead next to the walking path. All pavement/cement is OB. Walking path and beyond is OB. Secondary tee box provides a downhill tee shot and is located next to I-20(take dirt path past #7 basket up the hill till you find giant cement pad). Red line is painted to serve as tee box. Tee shots from secondary pad not allowed while holiday decorations are in use during the holiday season.
- Hole 9:** 244 ft (Par3) - Short technical hole between the tennis courts and the drainage ditch. Tennis courts, walking path and all cement is out of bounds. When there is water in the drainage ditch, it is considered OB.
- Notes:** McKinney Park is a small, populated park. All park patrons on the walking path have right of way. Disc golfers are not to throw discs while walkers are present. A spotter and/or a friendly, respectful warning that an upcoming shot will be thrown is expected from all disc golfers.
